

# WALKS & HIKES

## BANFF AREA

### BOW FALLS

Begin at Banff's Central Park at the corner of Buffalo St. and Bow Ave. After crossing the Bow River Bridge, this 1.2 Km trail will lead you along the south shore of the Bow River up to a rocky outcrop that overlooks the Bow Falls and then descends to the base of the falls for a spectacular viewpoint.

Duration: 25 minutes | Elevation Gain: 10m

### JOHNSON LAKE

A ten minute drive from Banff, take Banff Ave. and continue past the Trans-Canada intersection and follow the signs to Johnson Lake. Perfect place to take your dog for a paddle or walk around the lake.

Duration: 45 minutes | Elevation Gain: Minimal

## TUNNEL MOUNTAIN SUMMIT

Lower trail head located on St. Julien Rd from the Banff Centre overflow parking lot. Upper trailhead can be found on Tunnel Mountain Drive (closed to vehicles in winter).

To reach Banff's smallest summit, follow the well-graded switchbacks up 2.3 Km. This popular short hike offers 360° views of the townsite, Bow & Spray River valleys, Banff Springs Golf Course and surrounding peaks.

Duration: 2 hours | Elevation Gain: 300m

## CANMORE

### GRASSI LAKES

Drive up past the Canmore Nordic centre and park at the Grassi Lakes day use trailhead. An easy and popular trail leads to the shallow aquamarine Grassi Lakes. Cliffs above the lakes are frequented by rock climbers. Please stay on the trail as it does pass through a designated wildlife corridor.

Duration: 1-2 hours | Elevation Gain: 125m

### HA-LING PEAK

Overlooking the Town of Canmore, the popular Ha-ling peak trail is worth the effort! Drive up the Smith-Dorrien / Spray Lakes Road towards Kananaskis. Park at the goat creek trailhead and hike for 3.5 km to the saddle. Recent trail improvements have added stairs in some sections to reduce trail erosion. The view of the Canmore valley at the summit is spectacular.

Duration: 3 hours | Elevation Gain: 810m

## BANFF OFF LEASH DOG PARK

Located in Banff's industrial compound on Hawk Ave, the dog park is open from 7am-8pm daily.

This 1.5 acre area is fenced in, allowing your dog to run loose and socialize with all the local dogs!

## CANMORE OFF LEASH PARKS

Canmore has five dog parks, but the biggest and most scenic is the Quarry lake park, located near the Canmore nordic centre. It also has a small pond where your pup can take a dip.
